DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From North: Travel I-15 to Exit 93, turning east toward Blackfoot. Follow signs to the Eastern Idaho State Fair Grounds, but get in the left lane for approximately 1/3 mile as the road will curve to the left. Go right onto Judicial Street. Travel approximately .9 miles, turning left onto West Main (Highway 91) and stay in the left lane. Go approximately 1/2 mile and you will see fairgrounds on the left. Make 1st left after fairgrounds onto Highland, then make immediate left onto Jones Street following Jones Street for 1/3 mile, entrance is on left.

From South: Travel I-15 to Exit 93, turning east toward Blackfoot. Follow signs to the Eastern Idaho State Fair Grounds, but get in the left lane for approximately 1/3 mile as the road will curve to the left. Go right onto Judicial Street. After approximately 1 mile, the road will curve right then back left. You will go straight through 2 traffic lights. After approximately 1/2 mile, the fairgrounds will be on the left. - ♦ **No entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- ♦ **Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms** or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid.
- ♦ **Illegible or incomplete entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees or a returned check do not constitute a valid entry. The trial secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Those that have checks returned for NSF will be on a cash only basis for all future trials.
- ♦ **Eagle Rock Kennel Club and/or Pocatello Kennel Club is NOT accepting online entries.** Please mail, email, or fax entries so that they arrive on or before closing.
- ♦ **REFUNDS---Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club(s) will refund entry fees less \$5.00 per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate **must** be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.
- ♦ **Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.
- ♦ **No entry fees** will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request whether or not they have sent a copy of such with their entry. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Per AKC Rules and Regulations: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors on a grass surface. Ring size will be 100'x100'.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

- ◆ **The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ◆ **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The ERKC/PKC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The ERKC/PKC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the ERKC/PKC or any official thereof.
- ◆ The ERKC/PKC will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. - ◆ **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.
