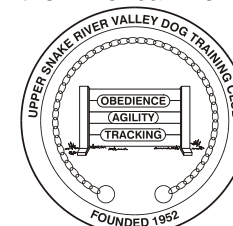

## DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

**Wind River Arena & Stables** *The arena is ¼ mile north of Ririe on State Highway 48*

**From Interstate 15 (from the south and west):** Take **exit 119** to US Highway 20. Turn east toward Rigby and West Yellowstone. Drive about **10 miles** to **exit 318** – “**County Line Road**”. At the bottom of the ramp, **turn right**. Continue across the railroad tracks to the stop sign. Go **straight** through the intersection, staying on “County Line Road”. Drive approximately **8 miles** to the stop sign, and **turn left** (SR 48). Drive about **½ mile** to the Wind River Arena & Stables **on the right**.

**From Interstate 15 (from the north and west):** Take **exit 128** “**County Line Road**”, at the bottom of the ramp, **turn left**. This road will lead you under US Highway 20, continue across railroad tracks to the stop sign. Go **straight** through the intersection, staying on “County Line Road”. Drive approximately **8 miles** to the stop sign, and **turn left** (SR 48). Drive about **½ mile** to the Wind River Arena & Stables **on the right**.

**From Highway 26 (from the east):** Take **the business Route of Hwy 26** into Ririe. In Ririe, Hwy 26 will intersect State Route 48. Turn **left** to follow State Route 48 to the west. Drive about **¾ mile** on State Highway 48 to the arena **on the right**.

**Note:** The driveway is fairly inconspicuous, and the arena sits a few hundred yards off the road, so you'll need to keep an eye out for it. It is the last of a series of gravel driveways before a small field.

**Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms** or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid.

**Illegible or incomplete entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees or a returned check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Those that have checks returned for NSF will be on a cash only basis for all future trials.

**Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed unless otherwise requested.** If you would like to know the status of your entry prior to the issuance of the judging schedule upon closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry. E-mail confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form.

**Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club is NOT accepting online entries. Please mail, email, or fax entries so that they arrive on or before closing.**

**USRVDTTC** may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against USRVDTTC or official thereof.

**REFUNDS**

**Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$5.00 per entry per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate **must** be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

**Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

**No entry fees** will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

### **MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION**

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

**NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process** When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. However, exhibitors should carry the original valid official jump height card/form at each trial to present upon request. (Chapter 2, Section 4).

### **DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

Per AKC Rules and Regulations: This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

### **MOVEUPS**

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an Agility title, provided that the request is made in writing (email is sufficient) to the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 pm, MT, March 19, 2012. Move-ups from Friday to Saturday will be allowed, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than at the conclusion of judging on Friday, March 23, 2012. Move-ups from Saturday to Sunday will be allowed, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than at the conclusion of judging on Saturday, March 24, 2012.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

## JUDGING INFORMATION

**Electronic Timers will be used.**

**JUDGING BEGINS AT 11:00 AM MT ON FRIDAY AND JUDGING BEGINS AT 9:00 AM MT SATURDAY AND SUNDAY.**

**Check In** will start at 10:00 am on Friday and 8:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Judges briefing will be approximately 10 minutes prior to the start of each class.

**Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging, if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. If a VMO or AKC Field Representative is available to measure dogs all dogs without a current height card will need to be measured. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused and not need to stay on site.

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**Running Order** Every effort is made to separate handlers running multiple dogs. The running order may only be changed at the sole discretion of the judge. Final class order will be determined after entries close.

### OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. Ring size will be 100'x100'.

### COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club or any official thereof.

The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club officers, board members, and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
